Accessibility

At Arlington Center for the Arts/Arlington Community Center:

The entrance at 27 Maple St is wheelchair accessible and has a round driveway for easy drop offs. There are two ADA accessible parking spaces along Maple Street as well as two spaces in the Community Center parking lot. There is elevator and lift access available on all 4 floors of the building.

At Arlington Town Hall:

Arlington Town Hall can be accessed through the front entrance via a ramp next to the steps. Alternatively, visitors can access the building via a side entrance, which is to the right of the building, through the Town Hall parking lot and there are multiple ADA accessible parking spaces in this lot There is elevator access on both floors of the building.

Public Transportation

Please take the MBTA 67 and 77 buses to the Mass Ave/Central Street or Mass Ave/Academy St stops. These stops are located directly in front of Arlington Town Hall and Academy St. The MBTA 350 Bus stops at Mass Ave/Medford St, which is .3 miles from Arlington Town Hall.

Parking

There are lots of parking options around the event! There are two parking lots located along Academy St that abut Town Hall and the Community Center that are open for public

parking. There is also free 4-hour parking along Academy St. There is metered parking along Mass Ave and there are also a couple of municipal lots nearby Town Hall as well.

Restrooms

All event locations have public restrooms available during the event. There are both gender neutral and gendered facilities available.
